FCE (T) Bichi Provost Assures Host Community of Fairness as Fodder Farming Commences



The Provost of the Federal College of Education (Technical), Bichi, Dr. Bashir Sabo Abubakar, has reaffirmed the institution's commitment to fairness and justice for its host community, Muntsira, as the College begins a fodder farming project.

Speaking during a crucial stakeholders' meeting held on July 21, 2024, the Provost addressed concerns raised by community

members who had begun planting trees on land earmarked for the project. The meeting brought together representatives of the host community, officials from Bichi Local Government, and security agencies to promote dialogue and ensure peaceful coexistence.

To resolve the matter amicably, the College management agreed to provide alternative farmland to affected community members. It

was also resolved that community members interested in farming on College land would be screened annually, allocated different plots each year, and required to pay a token fee to signify the College's ownership of the land. Importantly, it was agreed that no residential structures within the designated area would be demolished.

The Chairman of Bichi Local Government, Alhaji Hamza Mefata, pledged additional support by offering alternative land to those dissatisfied with the College's allocation. The meeting concluded peacefully, with both sides expressing readiness to collaborate for mutual benefit.

Demonstration School Holds Cultural Day and Graduation Ceremony
