PTA Chairman, Engr. Bello Gambo, appealed to parents to take greater responsibility for their children's education by ensuring prompt payment of fees and closer monitoring of their studies.

Also speaking, the Deputy Provost Administration of the College and overseer of the Demonstration Schools, Dr. Kabiru Shuaibu Musa, acknowledged the financial challenges facing the institution. He explained that the proposed review of school fees was aimed at improving teachers' welfare and assured teachers that plans were underway to integrate them into the mainstream college system.

Dr. Musa further announced new developments, including the establishment of a new Demonstration Secondary School on the college's permanent site, to provide easier access for members of the host community who consider the current location too far for their children. He disclosed that the Demonstration School is among the secondary schools that Hon. Engr. Dr. Abubakar Kabir Abubakar, Member representing Bichi Federal Constituency, has promised to support with repairs and new infrastructure, including the construction of laboratories, computer centres, fencing, and additional classrooms. He added that two new classes focusing on technical subjects and skills acquisition would soon be introduced.



The meeting unanimously approved a review of school fees, increasing them by ₦2,000 across the board, fixing the new rates at ₦9,000 for nursery and primary school pupils and ₦12,000 for secondary school students. It was also announced that the Kano State Government will begin covering NECO examination fees for students who obtain seven credits, including English and Mathematics, in the mock examinations.

Parents at the meeting commended the Principal, Malam Musa Usman, for his dedication, noting improvements in discipline, performance, and moral conduct among students since he assumed office.
